Meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman Russell Kottke.

Treasurers Report was read by Melissa. Balance on hand \$7898.35 in the checking account. Motion made by Kristie, supported by Jeff to approve the Treasurer's report. Motion carried.

Conditional Use Permit for Zimmerman Living Trust was discussed. Bob Bingen from Michels Corporation was in attendance to share information as well as answer questions. Michels plan for future expansion of the current quarry will be implemented in phases from South to North continuing with the Breezy Point Rd access point. A 10ft berm will be constructed around the entire work area and drainage will remain the same. Resident David Keil spoke in opposition to the expansion siting noise and dust as well as decrease in his adjacent property values. He also questioned if there would be trees planted on the berm. Mark & Dorothy Nehring stated that neighbor relations was the most important aspect regarding the quarry expansion and day to day operations. So far it has been positive. The board elected to relay a No recommendation on the Conditional Use Permit Notification.
