## TOWN OF TRENTON REGULAR BOARD MEETING FEBRUARY 20, 2023

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman Russell Kottke.

Crushing will be on an as needed basis only. All dust and noise control measures will be taken in order to minimize the effects of crushing on any neighboring properties. Motion to approve the conditional use permit was made by Jeff and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Kristie. Motion carried.

**Citizen Comments:** Kristie questioned on behalf of Dan Buwalda the ability to dig out the ditch along Balsam Road in addition to the tiling that was completed. Russell will talk to Dan to work on a solution.

**Road Report**: Plowing continues as needed.

It was decided to open bidding window in March for lawn and cemetery mowing.

Town of Trenton was audited for **Recycling Compliance**. Jeff made a motion to approve the updated resolution. Kristie 2<sup>nd</sup>. Motion carried.

Russell shared that we had 13 emergency calls from October-December of 2022 at the intersection of Hwy 151 & County C. With anticipated project construction not slated until Spring of 2027, we may continue to see this trend.
