REGULAR BOARD MEETING
JUNE 15, 2026

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman Russell Kottke.

Minutes were read by Karla. Motion by Kristie, 2nd by Jeff, to approve the minutes as read. Motion carried.

Treasurer Report was read by Melissa. Balance on hand \$8,116.05 in the checking account. Motion made by Kristie, supported by Jeff. Motion carried.

Liquor License applications were presented for The Wood Hill & Cantafios Buckhorn. Kristie made a motion to approve, Jeff 2nd, Motion carried.

Road Report: Russell reported that the wedging is done and we are waiting on the seal coating. He also shared that we have 2 trees that need to come down along Sunset Beach Road that were damaged in the recent storm. He will contact the tree service.

Citizen Comments: Earl & Kelly Braker expressed annoyance for the lack of effort to alleviate the noxious weeds on their neighbor's lawn. They shared a response they received from the DNR in regards to possible solutions to be taken by the town. Jayson Howard, a neighbor on the other side, also shared that he has thistles spreading onto his lawn. The neighboring home is starting to look dilapidated with shingles coming off and he is frustrated that the neighbor is not paying for his share of the shared well bills. Earl questioned who enforces the statutes. Karla will call the Sheriff's Department liaison again to try and get some help and/or clarification.

Jode Siedschlag requested that their group, Beaver Dam Education on Data Centers, be added to the July meeting agenda. They are prepared to present some documents and proposals to the board in regards to administrative oversights and policies for responsible land-use governance.
